The third quarter has proved that we can be more than a Ksh 20 million a month Company in terms of billing. More importantly, in our desire to provide quality water services to the entire Naivasha Sub-County we have managed, with support of various partners, to extend our services to new areas through implementing new projects. We also need to put more efforts in management of NRW which has dropped and increase the revenue collection efficiency. I also wish to bring to our attention on the growing cases of vandalism and meter theft. We have agreed to give incentives to the people who will help us bring the culprits to the book and also take legal action on whoever is involved. I therefore implore us to be on the look out and take care of our customers.

As we come to the end of the year, we need to look back at the goals, objectives and targets we had set to achieve within the year. Though some of the targets are way behind, our resolve and dedication to the residents of Naivasha sub-county has to make us more innovative, creative and resilient in order to achieve the desired outcome. When the going gets tough, we have to be tougher! That's who NAIVAWASCo fraternity are – resilient! It is still possible for each employee to excel amidst the current harsh environment. I also wish to urge us to use the lessons learnt from the experiences of the year as we develop SMART plans for the coming FY 2023-24

#### SANITATION SERVICES



Naivawasco promotes the development and implementation of safe sanitation services both on-site and offsite that are appropriate for different settlements types within Naivasha Sub-county.

Customers are required the following copies of documents to get a sewer connection:

- National ID
- KRA Pin
- Title Deed / Sale Agreement / Allotment Letter
- Approved plan

#### SIMPLIFIED SEWER

The company has adopted simplified sewer systems for design & construction of sewer line. Simplified sewer systems (SSS) provides a low-cost, flexible alternative to conventional sewers, and are suitable for densely populated low-income urban settlements. Simplified sewer networks are laid at a shallow depth so that not too much excavation is required, and inspection chambers are installed at considered intervals to allow for regular maintenance. Simplified sewer project has been implemented in Kayole that is Kasokoo phase 1 and the ongoing Kasokoo phase 2 (Camadee).
